
Known as "Israel's MIT," the **Technion** has earned a worldwide reputation for its pioneering work in electronics, information technology, water management, nanotechnology, biotechnology, materials engineering and aerospace. It is one of just 10 universities in the world that build and launch satellites. It is also one of only five similar institutions worldwide that include a medical school, encouraging progress in the rapidly developing science of biotechnology. The Technion is a recognized leader in stem cell research. It is one of only 15 academic institutions and companies worldwide approved by the National Institutes of Health for government-funded research.

David Meir-Levi is an American-born Israeli currently living in Palo Alto. He taught Archaeology and Near Eastern Studies in Israel in the 60's and 70's, during which time he completed his service in the Israeli military.

Since the outbreak of the second Intifada (9/29/00), he has lectured throughout Northern California and abroad on topics related to the history of the Arab-Israeli conflict and now has a weekly radio show, a monthly TV presentation, and a monthly column in a local Jewish community newspaper.

In his "day job", Mr. Meir-Levi is an insurance agent and investment professional, with offices in Menlo Park and San Francisco.

Directions from San Francisco Airport

Take the US-101 S ramp towards SAN JOSE.

Merge onto US-101 S.

Merge to 85 South towards Cupertino.

Take the Fremont Ave, Los Altos exit.

Turn right on Fremont.

Turn right on Grant Rd.

Turn left onto Fowler Lane (few feet before Oak Ave stoplight).

Turn to the house on the right side.

Directions from San Jose Airport

Take GUADALUPE PKWY.

Take the US-101 N exit on the left towards SAN FRANCISCO. Merge onto US-101 N.

Take the 237 W exit towards Mountain View.

237 becomes Grant Rd.

After passing Oak Ave stoplight take first right to Fowler Ln.

Turn to the house on the right side.
